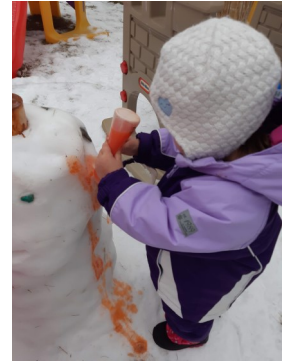

Banana Bread Recipe
