Educator Vacation time

In order to better support our Educators with taking care of themselves so they can best take care of children, it has been decided that Educators will now be allowed to take 5 days paid vacation a year. Until now any vacation time the Educators take were all unpaid. With this change, they will be able to take a week off or take the five days throughout the year paid. We went through a process to come to this decision, many of our Educators have been requesting paid vacation time. We met with our Board of Directors and surveyed educators on two separate occasions. This will be paid by parents, meaning if your Educator takes 5 days off that are paid you will pay for those and not receive a credit. They will be required to give ample notice so you have enough time to make arrangements. If you happen to require alternate care during those days you will need to pay twice (your Educator and Alternate care Educator). Any time off more than 5 days will be unpaid and if you do not require alternate care, you will receive a credit as usual. Please contact us if you have any questions.
