

# **Day Care News**

We will be closed on Friday, September 29<sup>th</sup> in lieu of National Day for Truth, and Reconciliation.



A national day to commemorate the history and legacy of the residential school system honours the resilience, dignity and strength of survivors and intergenerational survivors and remembers the children who never came home. It's a chance to engage and educate people about Alberta's colonial history and how it has impacted Indigenous communities.

This day is a new federal statutory holiday and is marked to reflect on the history of the residential school system – and the discoveries of many unmarked graves.

Over the course of more than 100 years, some 150,000 Indigenous children were ripped from their families and forced to attend church-run residential schools, where many suffered physical and sexual abuse, malnutrition, and neglect. More than 4,000 are believed to have died. The date of September 30<sup>th</sup> is to mark Orange Shirt Day, an unofficial day that has been observed since 2013 in



memory of an orange piece of clothing then-six-year-old Phyllis Webstad had taken from her on her first day at a residential school in 1973.
